

2026 – Open Wheel Modified Rules

Body:

DIRTCAR - UMP Body Rules will apply.

Weight:

2400lbs with driver

No per lap burn off.

Carburetor:

Only 1 naturally aspirated carburetor permitted.

Suspension:

1 shock per wheel. 1 spring per wheel.

No traction control devices allowed.

Tires:

Front: Hoosier M-30, M-60, Medium, or Hard. American Racer Hard or Extra hard.

Left Rear: Hoosier M-30, M-60, Medium, or Hard. American Racer Hard or Extra hard.

Right Rear: Hoosier M-30, M-60, Medium, or Hard. American Racer Hard or Extra hard.

Sipping and grooving allowed.

No altering tires with chemicals or grinding of compounds.

Driver's Compartment:

Racing seat required and must be properly mounted.

5-point racing harness required, must be within date and properly mounted.

Fire extinguisher within driver's reach mandatory.

Battery disconnect switch must be in reach of driver and safety crew.

Battery must be enclosed if located in driver's compartment.

Misc.

UMP Rule book will be referenced for any questions regarding rules in question.

Safety:

SA2015 or newer helmet with full shield required. No motorcycle helmets allowed.

SFI rated racing suit required. Top and Bottom. No Jeans, No work pants.

SFI rated racing gloves Strongly recommended.

SFI rated racing shoes strongly recommended.

SFI rated head and neck restraint strongly recommended.
Raceiver/Nitrobee One-Way communication required. Only one receiver permitted in car. **No two-way radios, no cell phones or rear-view mirrors permitted.**
